Dr. Darcie Greggs, P.Geo., FGC, FEC (Hon.) takes office as President of Geoscientists Canada for 2026-2027

Ottawa, ON – June xx, 2026 - Geoscientists Canada is pleased to announce the appointment of Dr. Darcie Greggs, P.Geo., FGC, FEC (Hons.) as its new President, effective June 6, 2026. The appointment was formalized during the organization's 29th Annual General Meeting, held in Saint John, NB.

Dr. Greggs is a highly respected professional geologist and industry leader with more than three decades of experience in the Canadian energy sector. She has held senior leadership roles, including Chief Geologist at Husky Energy, where she was responsible for technical quality assurance across integrated subsurface projects and led multidisciplinary teams supporting major resource developments.

Beyond her industry leadership, Dr. Greggs brings significant experience in professional governance and volunteer service. She serves as Director (Alberta) on the Geoscientists Canada Board and has helped advance professional practice standards and regulatory excellence across Canada.

In accepting the presidency, Dr. Greggs expressed her gratitude and reflected on the priorities ahead, noting that *"it is with great humility that I accept this role."* She identified federal licensure, geoscience education, and Indigenous reconciliation as her top priorities, emphasizing that these issues require ongoing collaboration and commitment across the profession. She also expressed appreciation for those who have contributed to the organization's success, stating, *"my thanks, as always, to those who went before—we would not be sitting in this room together without those people. My thanks to all of you. I appreciate greatly the honour of serving as your President."*

Also, during the June 6, 2026 Geoscientists Canada Board of Directors meeting, **Antigone Dixon-Warren, P.Geo., FGC**, Director for British Columbia, was acclaimed as President-Elect and **Ms. Beverly Smith, P.Geo., FGC**, Director for Nova Scotia, was acclaimed as Treasurer.
